




The Windows Driver Installation

1. Navigate to the Driver\Windows directory and double-click on the 'XPrinter Driver v8.2.exe' file. An installation window will appear. The software will automatically detect your computer's system, so manual selection is not required.

If the printer uses a USB interface, set the Printer Series to XP80-C. Before proceeding to the next step, click on "Check USB Port" to automatically detect the port used by the printer on your computer. Note down this port number.



2. Click on the "Install Now" button to begin the installation of the printer driver.
3. After successful installation, in the dialog box confirming the successful driver installation, click the "Yes" button to open the printer's properties dialog. Click on the "Print Test Page" button. If the printer prints a test page, it indicates that the driver has been successfully installed. If not, you need to specify the virtual USB port for the printer: Click on the "Port" tab on the window, then select the port detected by the installation program in the first step (e.g., USB004), and click the "Apply" button. Return to the "General" tab, then click "Print Test Page" again.



Note: If the printer prints a test page, it confirms the successful installation of the driver.
